*Brightspace Wiggio is a group communication and collaboration tool for students. Using Wiggio, students can hold group discussions, assign tasks to group members, poll members, share calendars and schedules, upload and manage group files, and communicate using live conference calls, video conferences, chat rooms, texts, emails, and voice mail. Wiggio also automates notifications via SMS (text) or email.*

## Accessing Wiggio

---

Access Wiggio from Communication tab in the nav bar of any course. At the prompt, click 'continue' to agree to allow Wiggio to access information. Optionally, click "do not ask me again..."
