About Blackboard Collaborate

Collaborate is a web-conferencing tool built specifically for live, multimedia, many-to-many collaboration using:

- Voice over internet (VoIP) audio, or
- Telephone audio
- Live webcams
- Breakout rooms
- Interactive whiteboard and content display
- Chat style messaging
- Shared viewing of applications/desktop
- Polling
- Session recording

What You Will Need

- 1) Two choices for Audio:
 - a. Headset / Microphone (preferred) or,
 - b. **Telephone** –A telephone number is available to dial into the session audio. To reveal the phone number and *your unique* PIN, click on the phone icon above the video window in the Collaborate online room.
- 2) Webcam: optional
- 3) High speed internet connection such as DSL or Cable.

Connecting to a Session


- 4) Depending on the access instructions provided by your Moderator/instructor, click the link that was emailed to you or click **JOIN** via the Clarion University D2L site (communication > Online Rooms)
- 5) Install the Blackboard Collaborate Launcher (first time use) and then open the meeting.collab file (or nativeplayback.jnlp for recording) in your preferred browser. If you previously installed the Launcher, proceed to open the meeting.collab (or nativeplayback.jnlp recording) file
 - i Browser must allow pop-ups
 - ii Launcher installation instructions can be found under Browser support.
 - iii Choose to "Accept" the meeting, then select your connection speed.
 - iv **Troubleshooting**





Configuring the Session

- 6) Configure audio for the room if using VoIP by running the <u>Audio setup wizard</u> in the upper right corner of the Audio and Video window. (see image below)
- 7) If using a telephone for the session audio, click the phone icon to generate your participant telephone number and unique pin number. (see image below)



Participant Tips/Best Practices


- I. The day before the session:
 - a. <u>Test your system</u>. By clicking this link, you will know very quickly if your computer meets the system requirements to open the Collaborate session.
 - b. Install the launcher and set-up your speakers and mic in the test Audio Configuration Room
- II. If using VOIP and built-in/onboard mic and speakers, Edit the session preferences to "Mute speakers when Talk is pressed" to prevent feedback. [Windows > Edit > Preferences] [Mac > Preferences > Edit] See Speaker and Microphone settings images below.
- III. If session seems abnormally slow or audio/video or content area is delayed/not coming through, make sure you have selected the correct connection speed. This can be adjusted in the Preferences. See Connection speed image below.






EDIT Preferences: Speaker Settings
