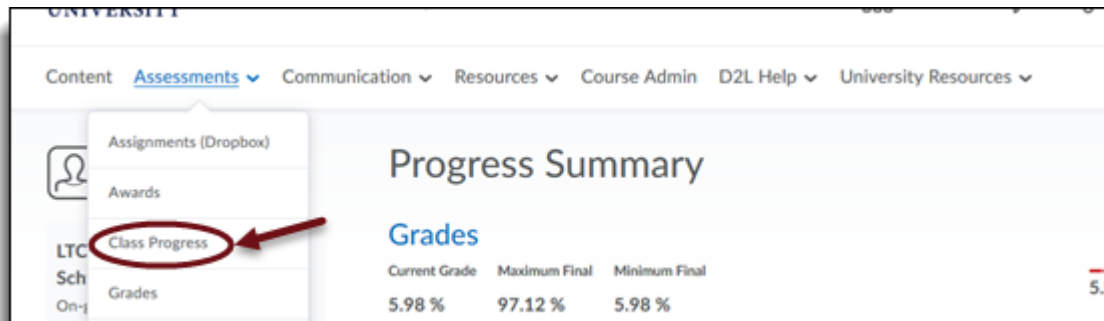


## Rubrics

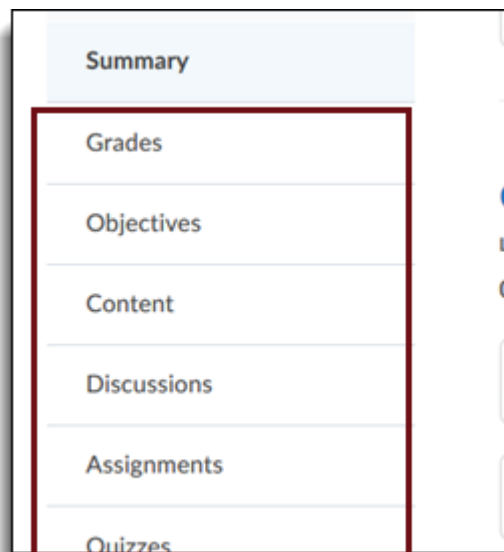
Professors may sometimes use rubrics while grading your Discussions. They are filled out by your instructor and posted for you to view.

### Viewing the Full Discussions Rubric

1. To view the areas that your instructor chose for you in your rubric, you will have to access it using the **Class Progress** tool.
2. Click under the **Assessments** tab 3. Select **Class Progress**

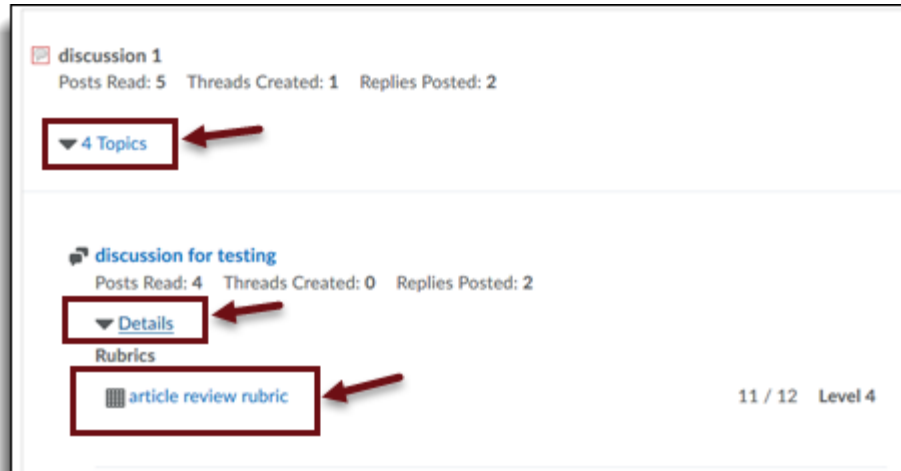


3. Determine the area that your rubric is associated with. For example, if you were graded via rubric in the Discussions area, you would click on that area from the list on the side.



4. Find the particular area that the rubric would be located under and select the **Topics** drop-down arrow link to expand all the topics.
5. Under the topic that was graded with a rubric, click the **Details** drop-down arrow link.

6. You are then able to click on a link to expand to view your results in your rubric.



7. When you are finished looking at your Rubric Evaluation Results, simply click **Close**.
