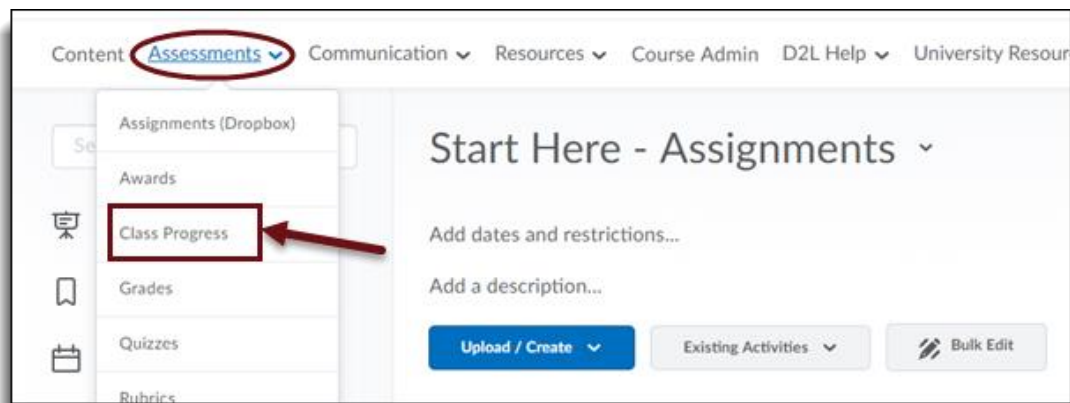


User Progress

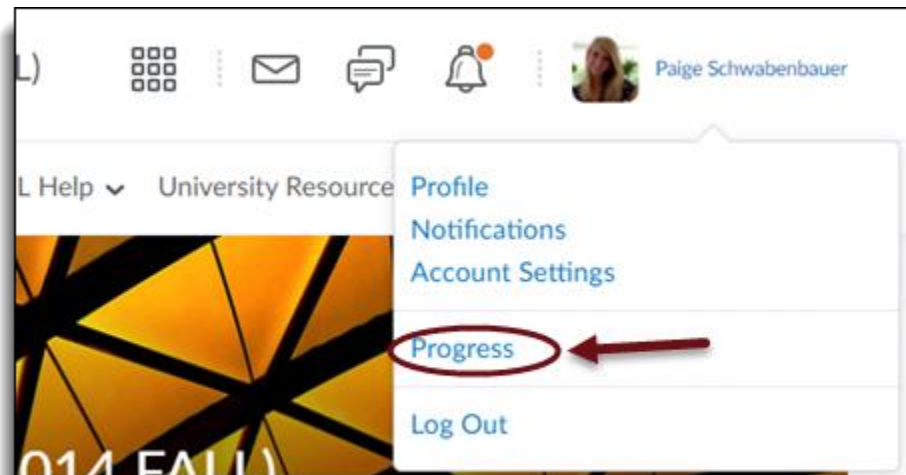
The User Progress tool helps you check your progress in a course through tracking course-specific assignments and feedback, and through measuring 10 progress indicators: Summary, Grades, Objectives, Content, Discussions, Assignments, Quizzes, Checklist, Surveys, and Login History.

Accessing User Progress

- 1) On the Assessments tab, at the end of the dropdown menu select **User Progress** from the navigation panel.



- 2) In the right hand corner, click on the users name. Under the dropdown menu select **Progress**.



Understanding User Progress

- 1) After selecting User Progress on the left hand side you should see your name and the name of the course you are checking your progress on. Below your name and course you will see a list of 10 items that tracks your progress.
