

College Spotlight!

Butler County Community College (BC3) is a public community college in Butler Township, Pennsylvania. It also offers courses in Cranberry Township, as well as in Lawrence, Mercer, Jefferson, and Armstrong counties. More recently, the college has begun to offer online classes.

BC3 has 37 career programs, 18 transfer programs, and 21 certificates in the areas of Business, Health Care, Humanities and Social Sciences and STEM. Through a partnership with the Pennsylvania State System or Higher Education, students can earn an associate degree from BC3 in one of twelve programs and transfer to any PA state institution with junior standing. Degree completion partnerships with Chatham University, Clarion University of Pennsylvania, Franklin University, Indiana University of Pennsylvania, LaRoche College, and the University of Pittsburgh give students the opportunity to earn a bachelor's degree in various programs while staying on BC3's main campus through classroom, hybrid, and online courses.

Tuition and fees for in-district Pennsylvania residents were \$7,850 and \$10,850 for Pennsylvania out-of-district residents in 2019.

Butler County Community College has no residence halls. A list of currently available apartment and room rentals is maintained by the admissions office. Estimated off-campus cost of living is \$3,600.

80% of BC3 students receive financial aid for their education and 70% of BC3 graduates are debt-free.
