California University of Pennsylvania is a public university in California, Pennsylvania. Founded in 1852, it is a member of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education. The university offers bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. It is accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education. The 294-acre campus includes top recreation facilities, best-in-class housing options, plenty of green space and an on-campus farm used for recreation and learning activities.

Cal U offers 100+ undergraduate majors, degrees and certificates; 95+ graduate and professional degree and certificate programs, and 75+ programs delivered 100% online.
