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# GIFTED *and* TALENTED ENDORSEMENT



All students need to make annual yearly progress (AYP) even those who are gifted and talented.

The 15-18 credit gifted and talented endorsement is designed to aid schools and educators in enhancing opportunities for students.

This program allows students flexible access to quality instruction in an online environment and is approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

Successful candidates will receive a letter of completion from Clarion University and be eligible to receive the gifted and talented endorsement from PDE.
