You can earn your graduate degree in three years or less with this 60-credit clinical mental health counseling program. It is designed for busy adults who cannot regularly travel to campus due to distance, jobs or family responsibilities.

Almost all coursework is online, with the exception of four hybrid courses that will involve one week on site each of the first two summers.

The program leads to eligibility for the licensed professional counselor (LPC) credential in Pennsylvania.
