Electronic Signature for Informed Consent in Baseline Electronic Consent Forms

The following policy is to be followed for research that requires a copy of the informed consent and the consent is being obtained via electronic means.

- 1. The informed consent screen must be one of the first screens displayed on the survey. If the participant selects "N", then the survey ends.
- 2. By pressing "Y", Baseline records that the participant clicked "Y", which would indicate an electronic signature.
- 3. When developing the survey in Baseline, the mechanism that ensures the respondents using those emails are the only ones who can take the survey must be used.
- 4. All participants should receive a copy of the consent to participate.
- 5. In the consent form immediately after the signature:

Options for receiving a copy of the consent form:

- a. press < CNTL > + P while on the screen to print the consent.
- b. Save to a computer: With the document open, open print. Save to PDF
- c. Receive an email with a PDF of the consent. Please notify the researcher.
- d. Photograph the consent form.
