Punt, Pass & Kick Rules

It is assumed that all Intramural Participants have read all policies and procedures in the [Intramural Sports Handbook](#). The purpose of this Handbook is to assure equitable and enjoyable participation as possible for all participants at Clarion University. All participants, referees and staff are responsible for all of this information

Players:

- Players compete as individuals
- Men's and women's division

Equipment:

- Balls provided by the Intramural Department must be used
- Metal cleats and sandals are prohibited
 - Rubber cleats or athletic shoes are allowed

Rules:

- Each contestant will get three (3) attempts per punt, pass and kick
- All punts and passes will be made from behind the goal line of the designated end zone
 - Contestants stepping over the goal line are penalized five (5) yards
- Any attempt where the ball is completely missed does not count as an attempt
- Tees will be available for kicks
 - Contestants have the choice to use a tee or holder during kick attempts

Scoring:

- Scores are based on both distance and accuracy
- Example: If a contestant passes the ball 30 yards, but the ball lands 5 yards to the right of the midline, the final score for that pass would be $30-5 = 25$
- Cones will highlight the midline down the center of the field
- All scores will be based on yard increments and rounded down to the nearest yard
- Any attempts landing in out of bounds territory will receive a score of zero (0)
 - No attempts can receive a negative score
- All scores will be determined from where the contestants punt/pass/kick first makes contact with the ground (bounces or rolls do not add to the score)
- The longest of the three (3) attempts will count towards a contestants final score
- A contestants final score is his/her cumulative total for the three individual events
 - Example: A score of 40 punting, 50 passing, and 20 kicking is a final score is 110

Tie Breaker:

- In the event of a tie:
 - Each contestant involved in the tie will compete in a playoff round
 - Contestants will get one (1) attempt in all three events
 - Scoring continues the same
- If a tie continues contestants will compete in playoff rounds until the tie is broken
