

2018 Winter Break Closing Notice

Break Period

The Winter break begins after your last scheduled class on Friday, March 9, 2018. Classes resume Monday, March 19, 2018.

Residence Halls

All residence halls close at 10:00pm on Friday, March 9, 2018. All residents must be out of the building at this time. **If you find it impossible to leave the building by the time stated above, PLEASE SEE YOUR HALL Staff – (Erin Neely for Campus View and Valley View; Jared Milligan for Suites on Main North; Corey Negley for Suites on Main South) by 6:00pm on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 to discuss alternatives. The suites will reopen at 1:00 pm on Sunday, March 18, 2018. Please schedule your travel plans accordingly.**

If you need housing for the break period or any portion of it, please see the “Break Housing” section of this document. Students are not allowed to remain on-campus during the break without permission from the Center for Residence Life Services.

Before Leaving for Break

Please prepare your room as outlined below before leaving campus.

1. Close and lock your windows
2. Leave your drapes/window coverings open
3. Gather and empty all trash
4. Unplug all electrical cords, except refrigerator and fish tank (see that a self-feeder is installed if leaving fish)
5. **SOMN/SOMS/Campus View/Valley View residents** – turn your heat/AC to 65 degrees on the heat setting
6. Turn off lights
7. Lock room door (and bedroom door if in a Suite)

Failure to comply with these instructions will result in documentation. You and/or your roommate will be considered in violation of the University conduct code if any residence hall/university policy violations are found in your room.

Break Housing

If you are unable to leave for the break (this includes students who are required by the university to remain on-campus) or need to return prior to the residence halls opening, you need to do the following: read, complete, and return the Break Housing Form to the Center for Residence Life Services prior to Tuesday, March 6, 2017. **NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED TO STAY WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION!**

Please Note: The University assumes no responsibility for personal belongings left in student rooms during break periods. You may want to consider taking your computer equipment, stereo equipment, etc. home with you over the break.
