Your 2017–2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. To verify that you provided correct information, the Student Financial Services (SFS) Office staff will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. Clarion may also ask for additional information. **Note:** Federal aid will not be awarded or disbursed until verification is complete. Failure to complete the verification process in a timely manner may result in loss of federal grants and loans.
