
MyClarion Student Center Quick Reference – Applying for Graduation

- 1. Go to www.clarion.edu/myclarion and select then "Login".
- 2. Next, click the **Student Center** link.
- 3. Click the My Academics link.



4. Click the **Apply for graduation** link.

Before applying for graduation, please review your degree audit to ensure that you will meet all degree requirements for the term you are applying for graduation. You should **only** apply for graduation the semester before you expect to graduate. This should be done during the period of registration. You are responsible for making sure you have satisified all requirements for your degree and should meet with your advisor to confirm. If any course substitutions and waivers are needed, you should make sure those are discussed with your advisor and submitted in advance if possible.

Please note: applying for graduation does not mean you are cleared for graduation.

5. Click the **Apply for graduation** link to the right of the degree information.





6. Select the term you expect to graduate and click continue. You must apply online before the deadline for the term.

If you need to change your graduation term after you have applied, please contact the Registrar's Office at registrar@clarion.edu.



7. If you are graduating in Spring or Summer, you will need to select a graduation location.



8. Review the graduation instructions and select **continue** to proceed.

Select a valid term to apply for graduation by selecting a value from the dropdown. Only terms in which you are able to apply for graduation will be displayed.




9. You will see the same graduation instructions along with your program information. At this time you can select a different program, a different term, or submit the application for the program.


10. After submitting your application, you will receive the following confirmation message:




11. Click on the green 'Review Diploma Name and Address' button to review and update your diploma name.






13. Click on Diploma Address to review and update your diploma address. Click on the green 'add a new address' button.


14. Click View my graduation status to check on the status of your graduation application.

- If your graduation status says 'Requirements Incomplete', please see your advisor to determine what you need to graduate.
- If your graduation status says 'Conditionally Approved', your advisor has approved your graduation application pending successful completion of coursework (ie. registered courses, transfer credits, incompletes, portfolios, etc).
- If your graduation status says 'Denied', you should contact your advisor to find out what is needed to finish your requirements.
