



College Spotlight

Clarion University is a public university in the rolling hills of Clarion, Pennsylvania. It is one of the 14 universities that are part of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education. The school was founded in 1867 and offers associate, bachelors and master's degrees, post master's certificates and a Doctoral degree. The university maintains a regional campus, Clarion University - Venango in Oil City, and a site in Pittsburgh at West Penn School of Nursing. Clarion also offers an extended studies program featuring online courses, remote sites, and various hybrid learning situations.

Clarion offers 175 academic program accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education. In addition, through other accrediting agencies, it offers 39 nationally accredited programs, which is the most in the state system. The College of Business Administration and Information Sciences has internationally recognized AACSB accredited programs.

Popular majors include Nursing, Liberal Arts and Humanities, Speech Pathology, Education, and Business.

Tuition and Fees for 2019-2020 - \$11,149 and Room and Board - \$12,544. Approximately 91% of Clarion students receive some form of financial aid. 68% of the 4,330 undergrads at Clarion obtained grant aid of around \$6,094.
