Geneva is a private, Christian, liberal arts college in Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania. Founded in 1848 in Northwood, Ohio, Geneva moved to its current location in 1880. Geneva offers over 145 undergraduate majors and programs of study, as well as 8 graduate programs. There are currently 1430 students enrolled, and the most popular majors include engineering, business, elementary and special education, biology and computer science.
