

Act 48 Application Instructions

Thank you for your willingness to serve as a Mentor Teacher for one (or more) of our BLOCK students. We truly appreciate your time and experience as we continue to develop the skills of our future educators.

Mentor Teachers of our BLOCK students are now able to receive 10 hours of Act 48 per student. To receive these hours, mentor teachers must complete four weekly observations, to be shared with the teacher candidate. This written feedback will be used to guide the teacher candidate and their growth throughout the BLOCK field experience. Please complete the Teacher Candidate Feedback Form and discuss the feedback with the Teacher Candidate at the end of each week. Teacher Candidates will upload their feedback forms to the School of Education's Chalk & Wire data platform. University supervisors will be able to use these forms to review the progress of each Teacher Candidate prior to their formal observation. This information will help us to determine where potential changes within our program need to occur.
