

Join us for a field and laboratory based research experience in the fundamentals of natural resource conservation.

In this week-long academy, high school students learn how to study wildlife populations, evaluate their habitats and sample for disease causing pathogens. Field-collected samples will be analyzed in the laboratory using cutting-edge tools in molecular biology, including DNA extraction, amplification and characterization.

Students will conduct field projects in which they will design their own research studies, shape data analysis and propose management strategies. In addition, they will have the opportunity to interact with professionals to learn more about career opportunities in fisheries, wildlife and laboratory sciences.
